

Re: Expiration of Local Television License on December 31, 2007

Dear _____,

The SESAC license agreement presently in effect with your station authorizing the lawful performance of copyrights represented by SESAC contained in programming (inclusive of commercial announcements, jingles, and promos) will expire in accordance with its terms and conditions December 31, 2007. As you have been notified by the Television Music License Committee (TMLC), there is no "interim agreement" that would provide you with temporary authorization to continue broadcasting (in programming, announcements, or otherwise) any copyrights represented by SESAC beyond the termination date.

SESAC is pleased to include with this letter license agreements that, when signed by a station representative and SESAC, will authorize your station to continue to broadcast all programming and related commercial announcements, jingles, and promos on your primary station and one simulcast digital channel. License agreements are also included in this packet that, when executed, will authorize all performances of music represented by SESAC on your station's web site(s) and will also authorize all programming containing SESAC music on your multiplex digital channels.

To assist you through the process of licensing your transmission of SESAC represented copyrights, you will find four instructive sheets, one for each of the four different license agreements contained in the packet: Blanket License, Station Web Site License, a Digital Multiplex License, and a Per Program License (an alternative licensing option to the Blanket License).

A **Question & Answer** sheet is also enclosed, which you may find helpful in answering questions regarding the license agreements and the licensing process. Should you have additional questions, please call 1-866-730-9841 and ask for Customer Service. Trained Licensing personnel are prepared to answer your questions.

To obtain the authorization that you require, please complete, sign, and return the license agreements to SESAC. Upon receipt, a countersigned copy of each of the license agreements will be returned for your records.
