Dear Local Television Broadcaster,

SESAC, Inc. has been engaged in good faith negotiations with the TMLC regarding terms and conditions of a five year Blanket License effective January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2012. While we have not as yet reached agreement with the TMLC, the management of SESAC wants to inform you, that, in the event that the TMLC and SESAC can not agree on the terms of a new local television license, SESAC will provide, prior to the end of November 2007, a Blanket License and a Per Program License option to each local television station.

The Blanket License will include a fair and equitable 5 year license fee schedule. The respective station allocation methodology for the primary station (currently analog) will be similar to the TMLC 2007 allocation.

SESAC will also offer each local television station a Per Program License as an alternative to the Blanket License. The terms and conditions of the Per Program License will be similar in many respects to the Per Program Licenses already available in the marketplace to local television broadcasters, though not identical.

SESAC plans to continue its good faith negotiations with the TMLC and is hopeful that an agreement will be reached prior to the expiration of the current agreement.

In the event that the ongoing negotiations with the TMLC do not result in a new license agreement, we hope that this communication brings you a level of comfort in knowing that your station will have an option to obtain a Blanket License or a Per Program License from SESAC that will allow you to continue to broadcast programming and commercial announcements containing SESAC represented copyrights beyond December 31, 2007. Each license will also include authorization for Digital television broadcasts and performance of copyrights represented by SESAC on your station's Internet site.

On behalf of SESAC's management, I thank you for your patience during these years of arbitration and negotiations. We look forward to moving forward in harmony with our Local Television Broadcaster colleagues.
